

The RFVRC team will work with members and families (one-on-one and in groups) to help them navigate life transitions, connect with critical internal and external resources, and build meaningful, independent lives.

Services offered will include:

- Occupational therapy services targeting a variety of common physical, social, cognitive, and environmental factors that may limit engagement in activities that are meaningful to our members.
- Explore different options for day, evening, and weekend programming in your area.
- Help in dealing with changes in life circumstances, such as the death of a parent or loved one.
- Parent, member and sibling support groups.
- Identifying needs for specialized services and providing resources to connect with these providers.
- Offering resources for learning about guardianship options and future planning decisions.
- Developing skills to build meaningful relationships.

CATALYST ADULT DAY PROGRAM (AGES 18+)





This NEW Day Program focuses on increasing confidence, life skills competency and efficiency through instruction and practice of new skills, development of previously learned skills, and modifying daily environments that may impact independence. Catalyst members will learn and practice skills in natural settings to facilitate skill translation to everyday life.

Catalyst participants will be best suited to the program if they have a willingness to learn and engage in both individual and group activities, and can can commit to a minimum of 6 months of Catalyst sessions. Minimal bathroom support, open communication and ongoing practice with their guardian/parent/family at home, an awareness of physical safety while performing tasks, and openness to assessments are additional criteria for a member to experience success in this program in its initial phase.
